In our Geography 'Maps' topic, Year 1 will be locating where we live on an aerial photograph, recognising features within a local context. We will be creating simple classroom maps and identifying the key features of the school grounds. We will be following simple routes around the school grounds and carrying out an enquiry as to how their playground can be improved.



In our Science 'Seasons' topic, Year 1 will be reflecting on their own experiences, We will be learning about the four seasons and the weather associated with each one. We will explore how seasonal changes affect trees, temperatures, daylight hours and clothing choices. We will plan and carry out our own weather reports, considering the knowledge required for this job.



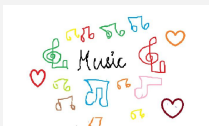
In Art, we will be learning about:



This term Year 1 will look at storybooks to inspire their art. They will develop their drawing and painting skills and will be given more complex art techniques to explore.

In Music we will be learning about:

This term in Music we will be learning about pulse and rhythm through traditional nursery rhymes. We will be learning about 'daytime' and 'nighttime' voices, as well as using and understanding the difference between singing and speaking voices.



English

In English, we will be: reading the story of the Colour Monster by Anna Llenas. We will learn all about nouns and adjectives and how we can use them to make our sentences colourful and imaginative. We will also begin working on creating full sentences, using a capital letter at the start, a full stop at the end, finger spaces between each word and reading our work back once we have finished.



In Character Curriculum, we will be learning about:
