following simple routes around the school grounds and carrying out an enquiry as to how their playground can be improved.



We will also begin working on creating full sentences, using a capital letter at the start, a full stop at the end, finger spaces between each word and reading our work back once we have finished.

In Maths, we will be learning about:

- Numbers within 20.
- Addition and subtraction within 20.
