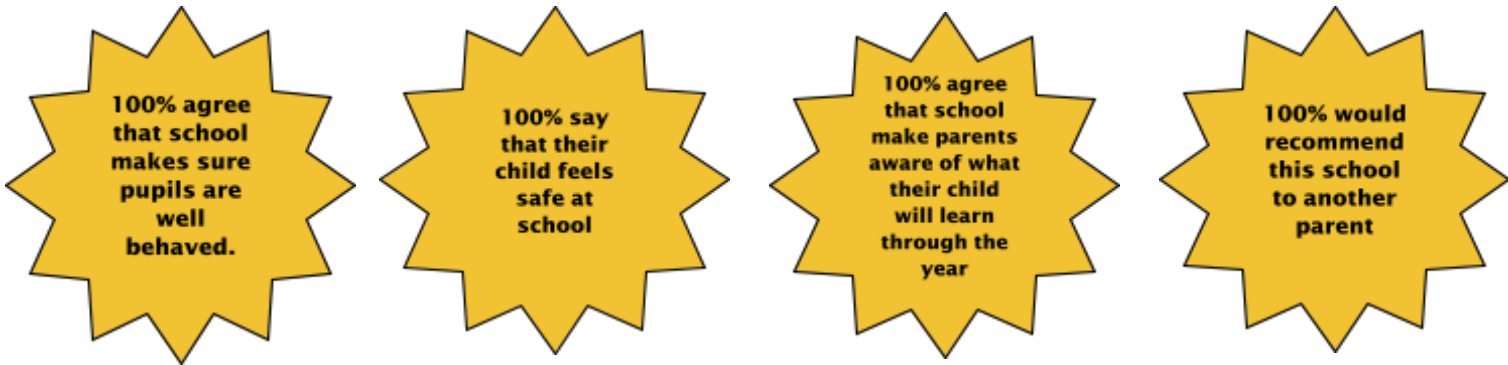


Parent Questionnaire Analysis December 2024


Parents- Headline Data

<p>Communication:</p> <p>Sometimes short notice provided for events for class trips or postponed events.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Monthly newsletters ● Calendar on website ● Text/ email service to inform parents ● Discuss at an SLT meeting as to how we can be more efficient with our communication. This might involve having a calendar of events mapped out a term in advance.
<p>Handling of payments outside the app for parents who receive government funding needs to improve (I.e. use of a Tax Free account and its applications is not known at the school, there is no clear process for this)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The School Business Manager has agreed to look into after school provision being paid using Childcare vouchers.
<p>Cost and range of clubs</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Ask the school council which clubs they'd like to have ● Is there an option that clubs could be organised on a half termly basis to make cost more affordable?
